18.97 SCOUTS BONFIRE

Councillor Serna reported that the Scouts' bonfire and fireworks display was to be held on Friday 2 September and that up to a 1000 people were likely to attend. The Spar had kindly agreed a £100 donation and Mitchell Skoda had donated £200. It was **resolved** that the Parish Council would donate £450 towards the cost of £900 for the fireworks.

18.98 REMEMBRANCE PLAQUE

The concrete base for the Remembrance Plaque for WW1 had been installed on the green outside the Community Centre/Medical Centre. A granite top was suggested, and this was agreed subject to approval by EF McFee, who was to do the inscription. Councillor Wilson would discuss this with him. An inauguration was proposed on 11 November opposite Elton Surgery. A wreath was to be obtained by Councillors Reading/Serna. Councillor Goodliffe was to ask Councillor Ackroyd if she would kindly take the 11am service. Councillor Lockhart would co-ordinate with the Police to ensure that cars were not parked in front of the Memorial on the 11th. Councillor Crispin would arrange for the Community Centre to be open for toilet use. Councillor Reading to ask Tesco for a donation. The Chairman would ask all Councillors to attend.
