

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
TRAFFIC REGULATION ORDERS**

NOTICE is hereby given that the Cheshire West and Chester Borough Council proposes to make the following Traffic Regulation Order in accordance with the provisions of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(ELTON AND INCE) (SPEED LIMITS) ORDER 2019**

The effect of the Order will be to introduce a 40 mph speed limit on the following lengths of road:

Ince Lane, Elton from its junction with A5117 Shotwick-Frodsham Road north-westwards to a point 48 metres south-east of its junction with Parklands Drive; and

Station Road, between Elton and Ince from a point 137 metres north-west of its junction with Ince Lane north-westwards to a point 218 metres south-east of its junction with The Square.

The Order will also consolidate existing speed limits.

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(WALKER STREET AREA, HOOLE)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019**

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on the following lengths of road:

- Phillip Street (both sides) – from a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with Walker Street to a point 5 metres south-east of its junction with Walker Street;
- Pickering Street (south-west side) - from a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with Walker Street to a point 5 metres south-east of its junction with Walker Street;
- Tomkinson Street (both sides) – from a point 5 metres north-west of its junction with Walker Street to a point 5 metres south-east of its junction with Walker Street; and
- Walker Street (both sides) – (i) from its junction with Pickering Street for a distance of 5 metres in a south-westerly direction; (ii) from a point 5 metres north-east of its junction with Tomkinson Street to a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with Tomkinson Street; (iii) from a point 5 metres north-east of its junction with Phillip Street to a point 5 metres south-west of its junction with Phillip Street.

**CHESHIRE WEST AND CHESTER BOROUGH COUNCIL
(BEDWARD ROW, CHESTER)
(PROHIBITION OF WAITING) ORDER 2019**

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting on Bedward Row (south side) from its junction with St Martin's Way for a distance of 10 metres in a westerly direction.

Full details are in the draft Order which, together with a plan showing the extents of the proposal may be examined at the Council Offices, Ground Floor Reception, The Forum, Chester between the hours of 9.00am and 4.30pm Monday to Friday.

All objections and other representations relating to the Order must be made in writing to the undersigned by 5th April 2019 and objections must specify the grounds on which they are made. Any representations made should specify the title of the Order and may become available for public inspection.
